Tylor has always enjoyed working with his hands and wanted a career in construction. After finishing college, he had achieved two Level 2 qualifications - one in Bricklaying and one in Plumbing. Even with these skills, he found it difficult to get an apprenticeship that would help him finish his training and move into full-time work.

Although Tylor had some site experience labouring, he couldn't find an employer willing to offer him an apprenticeship. He was starting to feel unsure about what to do next. That's when he came across an advert from the Creating Futures team for a Bricklaying Apprenticeship with Vectorex, who both Creating Enterprise and Cartrefi Conwy have worked with in the past.

The team encouraged Tylor to apply and helped him prepare for his interview, with his previous site experience and positive attitude, Tylor made a great impression, answering all the interview questions confidently and coming across as polite, hard-working, and passionate about learning his trade.

Tylor was offered the Level 3 Bricklaying Apprenticeship and started work with Vectorex on their Pensarn site in September 2025. Now working four days a week on site and attending Llandrillo College every Monday to continue his studies.



The project in Pensarn will run for approximately three years, providing a great opportunity to gain experience and complete his qualification. When our team visited Tylor on site, he was smiling and said how much he was enjoying his new role.
